More than 6,000 illustrated articles on people, places, and events in American history. Includes eras in American history, American Indians, U.S. states, the presidents, and much more.

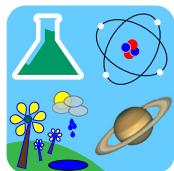
